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Message from the Clerk of Course

I invite you to tackle the Kuitpo forests for the final round of the SA Rally Championship and Autosport SA Clubman Series for 2008. It is with pleasure that I accepted the invitation from my car club to take the role of the Clerk of Course for this year's event.

We have returned to the Kangarilla Recreation Grounds to house rally headquarters with ample room for briefings and socialising after the event. The start and finish will also be at Kangarilla with the sports club putting on a meal in warm surroundings for you to purchase following competition, like a few years ago.

This year we have reduced the overall distance of the event and kept competition within the forests. We acknowledge and thank the staff of Forestry SA for their help and use of the areas. Besides the airstrip spectator point, which we have redesigned this year to give more speed to the action, we have designed the course to show off the cars in the Knott Hill forest stage in 1 minute intervals at the start of the event so that service crews have ample time to watch their cars in action twice and set up for service. Extra viewing areas are available later and for spectators who are not servicing. Full details will be in the Spectator Guide.

The organising team are working hard to ensure that the series final event is enjoyable for all involved with the rally, including competitors, service crews, spectators and officials. Recce is not hard with just five nearby forests used with plenty of time given to easily complete the notes and be fresh for the next day's competition. The event has a civilised start time and finishes early to allow time to relax and tell it like it was or should have been.

I again welcome interstate crews wishing to experience great forests in a fully pacenoted event.

I look forward to seeing you at the 2008 Southern Rally.

3.3 The CAMS Permit Number authorising the event is 508/2610/01

3.4 The length of the rally will be approximately 235kms for **SA Rally Championship** competitors, including 11 special stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 115kms and 89kms for **Autosport SA Clubman** competitors, including 9 special stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 202kms.

All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the Forestry SA forests on (closed) public, Forestry SA & private roads.

3.5 The Event will consist of one Heat on one day.

3.6 This event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

Article 4. – VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

Crews involved in accidents resulting in property damage are advised that they may be required to pay up to the first \$1000 of any claim to rectify such property damage. Refer Appendix I of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport for further details regarding insurance cover.

Crews found not to have reported damage to property at the next control will be reported to the stewards with a recommendation that a fine the equivalent to this be applied.

Article 7. - SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- 7.1 The maximum distance between nominated Service Parks and refuel zones will be approximately 108km (including 32km competitive).
- 7.2 Fuel will be available at the following locations:

Article 8. – RECONNAISSANCE AND PACE NOTING

- 8.1 Crews are only permitted to cover each stage, or part thereof, a maximum of **two times** with the exception of special stage 1, Knott short, which is comprised within the Knott Hill stage except for the last 400 metres, this has a **single pass limit** in its entirety

Reconnaissance by all crews is highly recommended.

8.2 to 8.9 See Series Regs

- 8.10 Reconnaissance will be permitted on Saturday 25 October 2008 between 1000 hrs and 1400hrs on Stages 1, 2/7,3/8 and 4/9 and between 1300 hrs and 1700 hrs on stages 5/10 and 6/11
- 8.11 A maximum speed limit of 70km/hr is not to be exceeded on special stages during reconnaissance. Monitoring of speeds will be undertaken by the Clerk Of Course and any infringements will be reported to the stewards of the event for application of an appropriate penalty, which may be as serious as exclusion.
- 8.12 All crews are advised to that they will be required to complete and sign a reconnaissance disclaimer (at documentation) noting the intent to undertake reconnaissance and use pace notes during the special stages of the rally.

IV. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINY

Article 10. - DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

- 10.1 Documentation and scrutiny will take place on Thursday 23 October 2008 at:
S & J Automotive, 33 Woodlands Tce, EDWARDSTOWN SA 5039
- 10.2 Documentation will be available between 1830hrs and 2130 hrs and must be completed prior to presentation of that vehicle for scrutiny.

Local competitors' vehicles must be presented for scrutiny on Thursday 23 October 2008 between 1900 hrs and 2200 hrs (unless granted an exemption, which needs to be applied for in writing to the Clerk of Course, one week prior to scrutiny on Thursday 23 October) If an exemption is granted the vehicle must be presented for scrutiny at: Rally Headquarters on Sunday 26 October 2008 at 0730hrs. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in a time penalty being imposed at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.

Regional and interstate competitors must apply to the Clerk of Course (in writing with entry form) to have scrutiny undertaken by the appropriate scrutineering authority in their local area. These competitors must present their documentation along with the endorsed scrutiny 'pass' form at the Assistant Clerk of Course, Marc Tillet's residence, 5 Dellvale Crt Flagstaff Hill SA (08) 8270 5573 on Friday 25 October, by arrangement, to receive event documents and register for reconnaissance. Vehicles fitted with a turbo charger must have the turbocharger sealed at the time of scrutineering.

- 10.3 Vehicles requiring re-scrutiny, or those local vehicles granted an exemption from Article 10.2 are required to attend scrutiny and documentation at Rally Headquarters at 0730hrs on Sunday 26 October 2008.
- 10.4 Turbo Scrutiny will be held for all vehicles fitted with a turbocharger on Thursday 23 October 2008 during normal process at the scrutiny venue, listed in 10.1. Vehicles granted exemption from Article 10.2 will be scrutineered as per Article 10.3
- 10.5 to 10.12 See Series Regs
- 10.13 Clubman competitors who have not entered the SARC will finish their rally at the Airstrip regroup after special stage 9 when scrutineers will check selected vehicles. Clubman competitors who have entered the SARC will have their cars checked at and during the regroup after special stage 9 and before the following service. These cars may also be checked at the final parc ferme at the chief scrutineer's discretion. Clubman Crews who report to this regroup will have been deemed to have finished the Clubman section of the rally, providing their cars pass scrutiny at the regroup regardless of whether they complete the SARC and report to the final SARC control and parc ferme. Cars which do not complete the balance of the event under their own power must be presented to the Chief Scrutineer at the final parc ferme.

V. RUNNING OF THE RALLY

Article 11. - START

- 11.1 Both driver and co-driver MUST be present at Competitors' briefing at 0830 hrs on Sunday 26 October 2008 at the Rally Head Quarters. Non attendance will be reported to the Stewards and the recommended penalty will be exclusion.
- 11.2 The Rally will start at 0900 hrs on Sunday 26 October 2008 and the first car will finish at approx 1700 hrs at Kangarilla Sporting Complex, Maurice Road, Yaroonna (Kangarilla).
- 11.3 Not applicable
- 11.4 Competing Vehicles are required to be placed at the Start location, no later than 0800 hrs to ensure readiness for the ceremonial start.
It is not necessary that a member of the crew is the person who places the vehicle in the Start Location.
- 11.5 See Series Regs
- 11.6 Cars will start special stages at 2 minute intervals. Cars starting special Stage 2 will feed in with cars starting special stage 1, with a 1 minute gap between cars but 2 minutes between cars on the same stage.
- 11.7 Special Stages will be closed to competition when the sweep enters the stage. Any crew who arrives at a special stage time control within their late time limit but after the stage has closed are to drive the stage abiding by all applicable road regulations. A derived time considered by the stewards to be fairest will be given to the crew. Crews are to enter their own start and finish times on the time card if the control officials have packed up and/or have left the control area.
- 11.8 Any crew that stops on a stage and is passed by the sweep is deemed to have withdrawn from that stage. If they rejoin the stage they are to drive the stage abiding by all applicable road regulations.

Chicanes & Course Markers

- 11.9 Chicanes or course markers may be set up in special stages. The chicanes and course markers will be constructed from bollards and/or bunting. Additional markers may also be used for extra route definition.
- 11.10 Overtaking is not permitted between the 200m chicane warning board and the chicane. The penalty for doing so will be 2 minutes per occurrence.
- 11.11 If for any reason a chicane is damaged or a car has stopped within the chicane area and blocked the course, the officials located at the chicane will display a yellow flag. When this flag is displayed each crew MUST slow down after the 200m chicane warning board to a non competitive speed. They must exercise extreme caution and be prepared to stop before proceeding carefully through the chicane. Any competitor deemed to be inconvenienced by this action by the chicane official will be given compassionate time off their stage time.
