Dear Competitor,

Welcome to the 2009 Wombat Rallysprint.

We have found two good solid sections of road at Walky Park, one around 4.5km and the other around 3.4kms. Time (and track condition) permitting, we plan to run each section 3 times in both directions, giving a total of 12 stages and a total competitive distance of approximately 48km.

Competitors will get the chance to look at each stage by way of a slow recce lap prior to competition on each stage. Hopefully this will stop anyone from getting lost and will also give crews the chance to make safety notes if they wish.

Remember, you don't need to be a Clubman competitor to enter. You just need the right car and licence and an appetite for dusty fun.

Walky Park has received a lot of loving care over the last many years from a very dedicated team of club members. 1 The Event

The event will be known as the 2009 Wombat Rallysprint hereinafter referred to as 'the event' and it shall be a Multi club Rallysprint and will be conducted on private property in the State of South Australia on Saturday, September 12, 2009. The event is open to financial members of clubs affiliated with CAMS.

This event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

2. Schedule of Dates

3. Authority

The event will be conducted under the general provisions of:

- a) The International Sporting Code (ISC) of the FIA;
- b) The National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS);
- c) The National Rally Code, Rallysprint Standing Regulations and the 2009 South Australian Conditions for Rallying;
- d) These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations/Instructions, Bulletins and Route Instructions as issued;
- e) CAMS Permit Number is 509/1209/01.

4. Organisation

- a) The Event will be organised and promoted by the Walkerville All Cars Club, PO Box 92, Walkerville, SA 5081.
- b) The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event
 - (i) if there are less than 15 entries; or
 - (ii) by reason of "Force Majeure".

6. Crew Eligibility

- a) Crews must consist of two members. The competitor and both crew members shall be required to hold a current CAMS Clubman Rally Licence or superior. Drivers must hold a current civil driver's licence.
- b) A crew member may only enter once as a Driver and must use the same vehicle and compete with the same Co-driver throughout the competition.
- c) Should both crew members wish to drive, then this will be permitted under the same crew eligibility rules and a separate entry form and entry fee will be required for each combination of crew.
- d) Crew must wear non-flammable apparel covering the body from ankles, to neck, to wrists with footwear and an approved helmet.

7. Entries and Start Order

- a) The attached entry form should be completed in all details and forwarded to the Event Secretary with the entry fee of \$150.00. CAMS Personal Accident Insurance cover is provided for CAMS competition licence holders.

It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their entry is received by the organisers before the close of entries.

A copy of the receipt for the transfer must accompany your entry form. Please remember to include your name as a reference so your payment can be identified.

- c) Competitors under the age of 18 years must have the written consent of a parent or guardian to enter and participate. The minimum age for Drivers and Co-drivers is 14 years.
- d) Competitors are reminded of the penalties under the NCRs for false statements.
- e) The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83.
- f) The field will be limited to 30 cars. In the event there are more than 30 entries received, preference will be given to those crews who have already competed in Clubman Series events in 2009 and any other crews will be selected to compete by ballot.
- g) Seeding order will be based on the current Clubman DPI and may be adjusted at the absolute discretion of the Clerk of Course.
- h) Cars may use existing numbers if available otherwise they will be allocated a number by the organisers which number will be marked on the car at the start of the event.

8. Running Details

- a) The event will be conducted at Walky Park.
- b) The event will be run over two sections of track traversed up to 3 times in both directions giving a possible total maximum competitive distance of approximately 48km.
- c) Scoring will be to the elapsed second. The worst time for each crew on each of the four sections will be disregarded.
- d) One slow speed convoy reconnaissance of each section in each direction will be conducted prior to the commencement of competition. The sections will be arrowed and Route Books will be supplied.
- e) Drivers' briefing will be held at Walky Park at 11.30 am. All competitors must be present.

- f) The first car will start stage 1 at 12.00 pm.
- g) The first car will finish at approximately 8.00 pm.
- h) The event is Round 2 of the SA Clubman Series and the SA Hyundai Series.
- i) Pump fuel will be available prior to the start from the Truro United Service Station which opens at 6am and closes at 9pm and supplies Boost 98 fuel and the Shell Service Station which opens at 7am and closes at 8pm and supplies Shell Premium fuel.
- j) Manual refueling will be permitted at Walky Park in the designated refuel area only.

9. Vehicle Eligibility

All vehicles must conform to the requirements of the CAMS NCRs, Rallysprint Standing Regulations and the current South Australian Conditions for Rallying. Cars entered in the Clubman Series vehicles must comply with PRC specifications or Schedule R requirements (All-Comers Category).

10. Scrutiny

- a) Scrutiny will take place at Walky Park on Saturday, Sept 12, 2009 between 9.30 am and 11.30 am at Walky Park.
- b) The latest report time to be eligible for scrutiny is 10.30 am. Cars presented for scrutiny after 10.30 am will be fined \$50. Cars presented for scrutiny after 11.30 am will not be permitted to start.
- c) Compulsory equipment which will be checked at scrutiny includes:
 - (i) Roll over protection specified in Schedule J of the NCRs.
 - (ii) Full harness seat belts that comply with Schedule I of the NCRs.
 - (iii) Stout mud flaps on each driving wheel.
 - (iv) A first aid kit that complies with CAMS Regulations.
 - (v) A fire extinguisher complying with NCR Schedule R Part 10, ie Dry Powder 2 kg.
 - (vi) Helmets.
 - (vii) Reflective safety triangles.
- d) The following documentation must be presented at scrutiny:
 - (i) Vehicle registration papers/permit showing ownership and verifying engine number.
 - (ii) Competitor and all current CAMS licences and club membership cards.
 - (iii) Driver's Civil driving licence.
 - (iv) CAMS Log Book (if issued).

11. Scoring and Timing

- a) All stages will be timed to the second.
- b) Crews will depart start controls at one minute intervals.
- c) Where a stage is traversed in the same direction more than twice, the slowest time taken by each crew on that stage will be dropped for scoring purposes.
- d) Crews should be aware of the requirements of NRC 5.2.

- e) There will be no penalty for early arrival at a start control.
- f) Late arrival at a Start Control will incur a penalty of 5 seconds for each minute or part minute that a crew arrives after their allocated departure time.
- g) Provisional results will be available 30 minutes after the last car completes the event.

12. Maps and Instructions

All maps and instructions required for the event will be provided by the organisers.

13. Protests

Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.

14. Awards

- a) Trophies may be amalgamated into a single trophy, where two or more trophies are owing to a competitor.
- b) Trophies will be awarded to driver and co-driver as follows:
 - (i) Outright: 1st, 2nd and 3rd
 - (ii) 1st in Class provided there are three or more competitors in each class.
 - (iii) The Clerk of Course reserves the right to amalgamate classes for awards where there are less than three competitors in a class.

15. General

- a) Navigation aids and under body protection are free in all classes.
- b) Disputes regarding entry in a particular class will be resolved at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
- c) All control officials and event officials are Judges of Fact.

16. Anti Doping Policy

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.
